



Official Scholarship Rules

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the Scholarship Form online at www.youbunk.com ("Scholarship Website"), including your full name, contact information, course of study, post secondary institution and your entry, in 200 words or less, in the space provided.
- You must explain why you or your roommate is the best roommate in North America.
- Your video should describe specific details.
- **Deadline for submitting your video is April 17th, 2009** at 11:59:59 p.m (EST).
- Scholarship will be awarded on June 1st, 2009.

THE RULES

- To be eligible, you must be enrolled in a post secondary institution during the 2008 – 2009 academic year at any North American post-secondary institution and must have reached the age of majority and must be living off-campus ("Entrant").
- Award is based on the quality of the Entrant's entry.
- Entries may be submitted either in English or in French. Only one entry will be accepted per applicant.
- Once submitted to the Scholarship Website, all applications become the property of YouBunk Inc.
- Any attempt to damage the Scholarship Website or undermine the legitimate operation of this promotion is a violation of the criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to prosecute violators to the fullest extent by law.

They may also be asked to provide proof of American or Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status and two letters of reference.
- The name of the Finalist will be announced on June 15th, 2009 ("Final Date") on the Scholarship Website.
- The Finalist is responsible for all incidental expenses incurred in connection with accepting the prize (the "Expenses"). The Finalist understands that he or she may not seek reimbursement for the Expenses from YouBunk Inc.
